- Joined with the Labor Council in pushing for Emergency Paid Sick Leave ordinances and raising the minimum wage to \$15/hour for workers in 4 North Bay cities.
- Fought beside our Healthcare allies for Healthcare For All and joined in the fight demanding PPE and health and safety protections for ALL healthcare and other essential workers.
- Stood with our Union sisters, brothers, and siblings at NUHW by holding a Workers' Rights Board hearing, giving voice to the abuses suffered by Memorial Hospital workers, who had been negotiating for a fair contract for over a year.
- Initiated an extensive farmworker research and outreach project to understand and build support for the needs and issues facing these essential workers.

As founding members of the Alliance for a Just Recovery, we continue to work with our community, environmental, and labor allies to push for policies that ensure sustainable recoveries from fires and other climate disasters.
